### List of Awards

**COMMUNITY HEALTH ACTION MOTIVATED PERSON (CHAMP) AWARD:** This award is given to a full time public health employee (not in a high-level management position) that exemplifies professional service in working with the public and fellow employees and who has made an outstanding contribution to public health practice.

**EMERGING LEADER IN PUBLIC HEALTH AWARD:** This award is given to an individual with less than five years practice serving in a public health capacity who has demonstrated outstanding initiative on behalf of the Colorado public health community.

**JOHN MUTH AWARD:** This award is given to a member of CPHA who has made an outstanding contribution to the Association.

**LEGISLATIVE EXCELLENCE AWARD:** This award is given to a person or organization for highly visible past or present efforts within the state or nation in support of public health issues.

**LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD:** Award is given to a person retiring from full time employment in the field of public health to recognize their lifetime contributions to public health.

**TECHNICAL INNOVATION IN PUBLIC HEALTH AWARD:** This award (formerly the JP Jacoe Award) is to recognize a person working in public health who has made an outstanding contribution in technology or physical sciences.

**ROY L. CLEERE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD:** This award (formerly CPHA Distinguished Service Award) is to recognize someone who has made an outstanding contribution to the Association and to public health in Colorado.

**SABIN AWARD:** The Florence Sabin Award was established in 1947 by CPHA to recognize achievement in the public health field by a person not employed full time in public health. This award honors the outstanding leadership of Dr. Florence Sabin in the promotion of better public health in Colorado.
